Can you buy a family ticket?	Yes event tickets – 2 adults, 2 children at £16.50 including booking fee
Can I buy a ticket on the night?	We expect the tickets to sell out before the event.
Will I be able to get something to drink and eat at the event?	Yes. There will be a small number of food and drink concessions on site.
What should I wear?	The Garden Festival site is close to the water front and it is likely that it will be cold and windy. Wrap up warm and wear a good pair of shoes or wellies. It could be wet underfoot. Bring a torch and maybe an umbrella!
Is there parking at the venue?	There are a limited number of parking spaces at the venue and spaces will be allocated on a first come first served basis .
Is there a charge for parking?	There is a minimal cost for parking at £3 per car CASH only purchase.
Is there disabled parking?	There are a limited number of disabled parking spaces. These will be allocated to blue badge holders only.
Is there any free parking?	There is free parking at Otterspool Park and it will take approximately 15/20 minutes to walk along the waterfront to the venue site.

By Bike or on foot: There will be a bike park at the venue which can be used free of charge.
Is there any parking outside the venue?	No. There is a traffic order in place along Riverside Drive prohibiting drivers from parking on either side of the road. This is to prevent congestion on the road.
Are there toilets at the venue?	There are a limited number of public and wheelchair accessible toilets at the event.
